## LENTEN RECITAL SERIES

The next AGO event is the Lenten Recital Series. Jointly sponsored by the Eugene Chapter of the American Guild of Organists and Resurrection Episcopal Church, a series of 6 organ recitals will be presented Saturdays, 4:00 - 4:45 PM on March 9, 16, 23, 30, and April 6, 13, at the Episcopal Church of the Resurrection, 3923 Hilyard St., Eugene.

The 2019 Lenten Series features organists from the University of Oregon:

March 9 – MIKE REITER (UO piano/organ technician) will play works by DuMage, Flor Peeters, Pachelbel and Buxtehude.

March 16 – BARBARA BAIRD (UO faculty) will present works by women composers from the 16<sup>th</sup> to the 21<sup>st</sup> century, including Fanny Mendelssohn and Clara Schumann.

March 23 – SAMUEL KALCHEIM (UO doctoral student) will play one of his own compositions for voice, clarinet and organ, as well as works by J.S. Bach and Pachelbel.

March 30 – HUNTER SLAWOSKY (UO undergraduate student) will perform his own set of variations on “Go Down Moses,” as well as works by Rene’ Salm, Johannes Walther, and Theodore Dubois.

April 6 – JOY SCHROEDER (UO doctoral student) will present works by J.S. Bach, Joh. Brahms, Wilbur Held and Buxtehude.

April 13 – BRAD SCHULTZ (UO doctoral student) will close the series with an array of Fantasies, from Sweelinck, Buxtehude, and Bach, to Vierne and Alain.

The organ recitals are free and open to the public. Please mark your calendars and plan to attend, and bring a friend.
